### What will I study?

You can choose to study either or both modules:

#### Module One

##### **Introducing Social Sciences**

This module considers topics such as personal change and human relationships in the second half of life, and will help you develop your study skills.

#### Module Two

##### **Growing Older in Britain Today**

This module will look at how personal resources, health and social policy, and technology are shaping the experience of later life – and how you can respond to this.

**You might wish to use this course to build your confidence, or as a springboard into academic study.**

The course does not lead to an award, but would help you (if you wish to continue your studies) to gain access to our new Postgraduate Certificate in **Enriching Later Life with Social Science** starting later in 2017.

£150 per module (you can study either or both)
